Northern Ireland Assembly Committees Who's Who

With the election now over and the Assembly back in session – confirmation of the new membership and structure of Assembly Committee's was announced during plenary on Monday 23 May 2011.

A large part of the work undertaken by the Northern Ireland Assembly takes place in Committees, where Members carry out a number of important functions such as the consideration of policy issues; examination of departmental proposals for primary and secondary legislation and the overall scrutiny of the work and expenditure of government departments.

Committees can also put bills before the Assembly. One recent bill which received Royal Ascent on the 29 March 2011 was the 'Assembly Members (Independent Financial Review and Standards) Bill' which was introduced jointly by the Northern Ireland Assembly Commission and the Committee on Standards and Privileges.

Assembly Committees fall within two distinct categories. Statutory Committees have a particular scrutiny, policy development and consultation role with respect to a particular Department. Standing Committees are primarily concerned with the workings of the Assembly, for ensuring that proper procedures are followed and that good governance is maintained. The Public Accounts Committee, which is also one of the Standing Committees, is responsible for overseeing government expenditure and for making sure all financial operations are both effective and transparent.

We have developed a handy guide to the Assembly Committee's new membership and structure overleaf, which we thought our business members might find useful.

Minister Sammy Wilson MP MLA delivered a briefing to NIABT members on the government spending review and the implications this would have for the Northern lealand draft Budget. The increase in VAT, cuts to benefits and the freezing of public service pay were all topics raised by members for discussion at the event.

As well as the inevitable haish facts on the cuts to come, the Minister spoke positively about the challenges ahead and the innovative ways revenue could be roised, including the new plastic bags tax which should generate revenue of approximately £4 million.



William Wright, Chair of Wright Group, Bollymena and long term NiABT member was the guest speaker at the Radisson Roe Hotel in Limawady, at the first ever North West President's Dinner in January 2011, An audience of over 60 local business representatives aftended this event which also resulted in a number of fresh membership applications from the North West area.



Eddle Bannon and Philip McTaggart from PIPS Programmes concluded the suicide awareness programme, the first session of which was provided in November 2010, A large number of MLAs and business members attended this important programme which highlighted the plight of suicide, especially amongst young people in Northern Ireland, and provided a number of pointers for recognishing those of tisk.



Phil McDonagh (ex PricewaterhouseCoopers) delivered a briefing on how the manufacturing sector can lead economic growth. Philip highlighted the important role to be played by of the manufacturing sector in helping to rebalance the Northern Ireland economy, to the local economy.



At the annual President's Dinner, the keynote specifier was Sammy Mison MP MIA. Minister Wilson spoke at length about the economic challenges facing Northern treland, both for the private sector and the public sector. An audience of 120 business members and MIAs attended the dinner. This topic was of particular interest to members in light of the Northern Teland draft budget.



Bombardier Aerospace hosted an educational seminar on its business and functions which was well attended by MLAs and business members alike. Alea McRitchie, Director of Communications and Public Affairs for Bombardier Aerospace delivered a presentation on how Bombardier has enhanced its technological capabilities through an on-going commitment to and financial investment in research and development.

The presentation was followed by a tascinating tour of the factory, which included the main tuselage assembly facility and the new manufacturing and assembly wing.



In partnership with the Institute of Directors (ICD), the NIABT hosted a seminar and panel discussion with local MPs. Joanne Stuart, Char of the ICD expertly chaired the debate and a subsequent Q. 8. A session. A panel of MPs were on hand to discuss and answer questions on matters not yet devolved to the Northern lietland Assembly. Such issues commonly referred to as Reserved Matters, included responsibility for setting the national minimum wage and the administration of financial services all of which have relevance to businesses here. The seminar also provided attendees with a unique apportunity to gain an insight into the role of an MP at Westminster.



The NIABT breakfast on the opening day of the Balmoral Show was a hive of activity with local businesses such as Tayto, Mash Direct and Dunbla getting together to discuss common ground.

First Minister Pater Robinson MLA and Patsy McGlone MLA spoke to an audience of over 120 business people on the importance of the agri-tood industry to the Northern Ireland economy, and how sharing information between businesses and MLAs can lead to new and exciting economic apportunities.



Frances Hill, The Bank of England's Agent for Nothern Ireland presented an off the record briefing on the Bank of England's quarterly inflation Report (February 2011). Frances explained in detail how the Bank of England inflation Report is published on a quarterly basis and sets out the detailed economic analysis and inflation projections on which the Bank's Monetary Policy Committee bases its interest rate decisions.




John Gibson, Head of Procurement for the Northern Iroland Assembly led a seminar for business members on Public Sector Procurement in Northern Ireland and the challenges it faces; Discussions included new regulations such as the EU Remedies Directive, the Impact of the Comprehensive Spending Review (CSR) on procurement, the gap between commissioning and procurement and the Impact of legal challenges.

The seminar also encouraged discussion on improving awareness for suppliers and how procurement procedures can provide greater value for money for the public purse.

Based on feedback received at the event, many businesses felt that they had gained a much better understanding of the public procurement process including on Issues around demonstrating value for money.
