## **European Issues: A Background to the Briefing**

In June 2008, the NI Assembly OFMDFM Committee undertook a fact-finding visit to the Office of the Northern Ireland Executive in Brussels. This prompted the Committee to consider how the Northern Ireland Assembly and the Executive engage with the European institutions and the best approach to take with this engagement.

The Terms of Reference for this consideration were as follows:

- To review the Northern Ireland Assembly's role in relation to European issues and to make recommendations to improve scrutiny of European policy and enhance engagement with European issues.
- To consider the Northern Ireland Executive's strategic approach to European issues, including in particular the Executive's response to the work of the Barroso Taskforce.
- To consider European policy issues which fall within the remit of the Committee for the Office of the First Minister and deputy First Minister.

The Committee has formally considered the Report on five separate occasions and a substantial portion of the Report has been agreed. The Report is now due for debate on Tuesday 26th January 2010 at the Assembly.

Danny Kennedy MLA has kindly agreed to give a presentation on the inquiry to the NIABT immediately after it has been debated at the Assembly and to respond to any questions regarding the Report at the breakfast briefing. This is a unique opportunity to obtain insight into the worthwhile work of the Assembly Committees at the earliest possible opportunity.
