The Committee for Employment and Learning has undertaken an inquiry into Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance (CEIAG) in Northern Ireland.

The purpose of the Inquiry was to identify areas where the CEIAG strategy for Northern Ireland is failing to meet the needs of target groups including school age pupils, young people and the unemployed.

During the Committee's evidence gathering it heard from employers and sector skills councils on the need for careers advice that is reflective of the employment opportunities that are available and that there is a need for better labour market intelligence to reach schools to prepare students for a changing economy.

The Chair of the Committee, Robin Swann MLA, will deliver a briefing on the findings of the Inquiry.
