

- Engagement with EU business networks and associations eg. EURADA







Support chain for funding/policy engagement










Scottish Uptake of ETC Programmes 2007-2014






European Territorial Cooperation uptake by Scottish Partners

Scotland Europa Support for 2014-2020

- Moving toward more of a cross-cutting thematic support on EU Programmes, rather than EU Programme expertise
- Combining EU Policy and EU Funding expertise for strategic projects
- Development of an EU Funding Portal: Projects; Programmes;
 Partnering
- Continuing to host National and Regional Contact Points for EU Programmes



Horizon 2020 Awareness Raising

- 2010 Scotland Europa, SE, HIE and SFC begin working with the Scottish Government to develop a more strategic coordinated Scottish approach to the EU Research and innovation programme for 2014-2020
- General Awareness Raising on Horizon 2020: 6 sessions, 400 attendees
- Sectoral/thematic capacity building events: 8 sessions from Green Energy, Life and Chemical Sciences to Food Security and Climate
- Designated support for the SME Instrument
- Project development support (for all of Horizon 2020)
- Development of a Horizon 2020 Innovation Voucher
